**Eligibility:** Judoka must be in the designated age and weight divisions, according to their entrance form. Changing weight divisions will result in a \$10.00 charge.

**Location:** Acadia Recreation Complex 240 - 90th Ave. S.E. Calgary, Alberta Canada

**Awards:** First, Second and Third Place medals  
Eiki Kawano technical awards  
*Judoka are required to wear their judogi or an official team tracksuit to claim their awards.*

## **Tournament Rules**

- I.** If a competitor registers in more than one division, it is their responsibility to appear for all of their matches. Although efforts will be made to prevent it, a competitor's matches may conflict, and if they do not show up, they will forfeit that match.
- II.** IJF rules will apply with the following exceptions:
  - a 3m common safety area will be used between competition areas
  - Blue judogis will be optional for all divisions. First competitor called will wear a blue judogi or a blue sash. The second competitor called must wear a white sash if the first competitor wears a blue sash.
  - Judo Canada rules will be applied to U17 and younger divisions
  - Rest periods between matches will be the length of the match time for that division.
- III.** Judo Canada rules:
  - U17 - No kansetsu waza
  - U15 - No kansetsu waza, no shime waza, no san kaku gatame or san kaku rollover, No Golden Score
  - U13, U11, U9
    - No kansetsu waza, no shime waza and no san kaku waza
    - No Golden Score
    - No head locking with a grip over or around the neck
    - No drop down techniques, which start on one or both knees
    - No Tani otoshi, or makikomi waza, or sutemi waza
    - Gripping is only allowed at the front of the judogi
    - Two medicals are permitted along with stoppage for bleeding
  - U9 and U11 matches will be in the form of 2 minute randori sessions. All U9 and U11 competitors will be grouped into pools of 3 or 4 competitors, where possible.

- IV. True Double Elimination draw for divisions with five or more competitors, Round Robin draw for divisions with three or four competitors, Best of Three draw for two competitors. For divisions where there is only one competitor the Tournament Chairman or Director may permit exhibition matches provided the weight separation of the contestants is no more than one weight division.
- V. Females must wear a plain white tee shirt under judogi.
- VI. Judoka must be paid-up member of provincial, state or country association and be able to prove current membership (referees, coaches and competitors) and age (competitors only).

The Tournament reserves the right to make changes where necessary.

**Team Competition Rules**

1. Team competitors must complete the appropriate waiver and compete in the regular portion of the competition to be eligible for the team competition.
2. Team members must be blue belt and above AND BE OF LEGAL AGE (18 or older).
3. Five person teams, 2 men under 81 kgs, 2 men over 81 kgs and 1 female any weight.
4. The winning team will be determined by the number of wins. If this results in a tie, the winning team will be determined by the points. If still tied, then each team will pick a fighter to compete against each other. If still tied, each team will chose a new fighter and they will compete, etc.
