CLUB SPONSORSHIP BY VOTING MEMBERS

PURPOSE:

To provide guidelines to voting members of the Association who sponsor clubs of which they are not personally a member.

POLICY:

Judo Alberta recognizes that there may be clubs which do not have an instructor who is a holder of a black belt recognized by Judo Canada. The By-Laws of the Association specify that such clubs must be sponsored by a voting member of the Association (Article IX, Section 6). When agreeing to sponsor such a club, voting members should be aware of what the position entails. The following in intended as a guide and is not to be considered exhaustive of the requirements.

The voting member sponsor is responsible:

- 1. To be sure that the sport of Kodokan Judo is taught in the correct manner.
- 2. To be sure that the principles of the NCCP are followed
- 3. To visit the club regularly and observe the training sessions.
- 4. To be present for all grading examinations.
- 5. To assist the club instructor as requested.
- 6. To ensure they meet the requirements of Policy # 6~01.
