The Steveston Judo Club cordially invites Judoka to participate in their 29th annual Pacific International Invitational Judo Tournament. **This year the tournament will be held at the Richmond Olympic Oval. We expect a contingent of approximately 12 judoka from All Tokyo University Judo Federation Japan.**

Team matches and Nage-no kata & Katame-no kata competitions are planned pending number of entries.

This tournament is a Judo Canada Regional Points Tournament and also a selection tournament for BC athletes wishing to participate in the 2014 Canadian Senior Nationals.

As this is a **Regional Points Tournament**, we would appreciate the assistance of referees **National "C"** or higher.
Referee Evaluation Tournament for **National "B"** and **"C"** pending numbers.

Elimination: Modified double elimination for divisions with more than 5 contestants.
The gold medal match in the winner's bracket will determine first and second place.
Round-robin for divisions with 5 or less contestants.

Divisions: The Tournament Director reserves the right to alter the Intermediate Men and Women's weight divisions if the numbers in these divisions warrants such changes.

Medals: Medals will be awarded for first, second and third place.
All medal winners must win at least one match.

Team Matches: We are considering a team competition consisting of 3 males (light, medium & heavy) and 2 females (light & medium). Trophy or cash prize for 1st place. Details TBA.

Eligibility: All participants must be members in good standing with their respective local and national judo associations. Proof of valid membership may be requested at weigh-in.

Out of Province: All out of province competitors will be required to submit a waiver form. This is to be signed by a parent or guardian for those competitors under 18 years of age.

Rules: Current IJF Regulations will be announced at the referee clinic.

- Blue & White judogi's are mandatory.
- Athletes can only fight in one division per day.
- Golden Score will be applied for all divisions.
- Arm locks are not permitted for U-16 divisions.

Doping

Control: Each participant in the Pacific International is subject to a doping control according to regulations by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES). Athletes and coaches must be familiar with these regulations. You can access the CCES Policy at: www.cces.ca. In case you have no access to the Internet, request a hard copy of the CCES Policy from Judo Canada.
