Eligibility: Open to all members of Judo Provincial/Territorial Associations and IJF Associations of other countries. Minimum rank is **YELLOW**. All participants must provide proof of current affiliation. **NOTE**: All Canadian participants must provide their 2018-2019 Judo Canada Membership Card and picture ID for U16 and older at weigh-in.

## **SHIAI**

IJF rules apply unless otherwise announced by the Organizers of the Red Deer Invitational tournament. Judo Canada and Judo Alberta sanction regulations as of the tournament date will be in effect. The Tournament Director reserves the right to make any changes in the best interests of the tournament and contestants.

- Where possible, U10 & U12 groups will be made of up to 4 judoka of like age and weight as submitted. Submission of incorrect or guessed weights could eliminate a judoka from participating
- The first competitor called must wear a white judogi. Blue judogis are **NOT** mandatory but if chosen must be the second name called.
- Plain white t-shirt mandatory for all female divisions
- Access to joseki area is reserved for athletes. Coaching will be done from the spectator side of the mats

## **Ne-Waza Competition**

- Born in 2004 or earlier
- Open to belt rank green and up
- Where possible, competition groups will be made up of up 4 judoka of like weight

## Match duration and category descriptions:

**U10 & U12** 2 minute, non-stop matches; possible mixed gender determined by age and reported weights. Categories will consist of 4 competitors where possible and will follow a round robin format.

<b>U14</b>	3 minute matches	Divisions of 2:	best out of 3
<b>U16</b>	3 minute matches	Divisions of 3, 4, 5:	round robin
<b>U18</b>	4 minute matches	Division of 6, 7:	double knockout
<b>U21</b>	4 minute matches	Divisions of 8+:	modified double
<b>Senior Men</b>	4 minute matches		
<b>Senior Women</b>	4 minute matches

U18 Cadet Women (born 2002-2005\*) yellow belt & up -40, -44, -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, +70

U21 Women (born 1999-2004) yellow belt & up -44, -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, -78, +78

Senior Women (born 2004 & earlier) yellow belt & up -44, -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, -78, +78

U10 Boys (born 2010-2011) yellow belt & up

U12 Boys (born 2008-2009) yellow belt & up

U14 Boys (born 2006-2007) yellow belt & up -34, -38, -42, -46, -50, -55, -60, -66, +66

U16 Juvenile Boys (born 2004-2007\*) yellow belt & up -38, -42, -46, -50, -55, -60, -66, -73, +73

U18 Cadet Men (born 2002-2005\*) yellow belt & up -46, -50, -55, -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, +90

U21 Men (born 1999-2004) yellow belt & up -55, -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, -100, +100

Senior Men (born 2004 & earlier) yellow-blue belt -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, -100, +100

Senior Men (born 2004 & earlier) brown & black belt only -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, -100, +100

**\*2006 or earlier who qualify as an "Early Bloomer" must meet the requirements set out in the online waiver and are subject to Tournament Organizers approval.**
