Hello everyone,

Judo Alberta plan to take teams to the 2022 USJF/USJA National Championships and the Junior US Open in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

**Minimum Eligibility:** U16/U18/U21/SR Provincial Team Member and/or CWG Age Athletes

Judo Alberta HP Coach Committee will consider other Judo Alberta judoka who do not meet the above minimum criteria on a case-by-case request.

**Option 1A: Two Competitions / Camp / Universal Studios**

Departure July 21, 2022 / Return August 02, 2022

Approximate Hard Cost: \$2,150.00 - *Flight / Hotel / Ground Transport/Universal Studios*

Canada Winter Games Funding: Approx. \$900.00

Competition Entry Fee & Camp Fees will vary based on the number of divisions athletes are competing. (\$105.00USD Per Division / Camp \$60.00USD a day)

**Option 1B: Two Competitions / Camp**

Departure July 21, 2022 / Return August 02, 2022

Approximate Hard Cost: \$1,850.00 - *Flight / Hotel / Ground Transport*

Canada Winter Games Funding: Approx. \$900.00

Competition Entry Fee & Camp Fees will vary based on the number of divisions athletes are competing. (\$105.00USD Per Division / Camp \$60.00USD a day)

**Option 2: Junior US Open / Camp**

Departure July 27, 2022 / Return August 02, 2022

Approximate Hard Cost: \$1,550.00 - *Flight / Hotel / Ground Transport*

Canada Winter Games Funding: Approx. \$700.00

Competition Entry Fee & Camp Fees will vary based on the number of divisions athletes are competing. (\$105.00USD Per Division / Camp \$60.00USD a day)

**Insurance:** If Judoka don't have a family insurance plan that covers international travel Judo Alberta will provide it. We will be exploring Covid travel insurance pending on travel regulations at the time.





**Canada Winter Games Funding Selection:**

Judo Alberta will select 20 athletes to be funded who are 2023 Canada Winter Games Eligible for the Florida Competition Tour.

- Athletes must win 1 match to receive points
- Divisions with no athletes will be credited 50% 1<sup>st</sup> place points; if they enter a higher weight division, they will be credit with 100% of the points if they win a match

Judo Clubs will be asked to submit names and which option for their athletes are interested in.

**Note:** Athletes who are part of the cadet national team and junior national team can still participate in these events as they do not conflict with national team events.
