# Judo Alberta Ne-waza Selection Policy 2026 Open Nationals

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1) Member in good standing with Judo Alberta
- 2) Practices regularly at Judo Alberta Club (minimum 2 times a week)
- 3) Participates in one provincial training camp or two regional camps. (Sept-2025 February2026)
- 4) Participates in provincial camp or regional camp April/May 2026 Prior to the 2026 Open Nationals
- 5) Participate in a Ne-waza competition during the 2025-2026 season. (September 2025 to April 2026)

#### Selection procedure:

- A) Judo Alberta Coach Committee Reviews the athlete's minimum selection requirements.
- B) Judo Alberta Executive Reviews the selection procedure
- C) Judo Alberta notifies Judo Club Coaches of athlete's final selection.

Funding: Judo Alberta will not provide funding for ne-waza competitors.

Cost: The approx. cost for the 2026 Open Nationals will be \$600.00-\$800.00.

## **Judo Alberta Veterans Selection policy 2026 Open Nationals**

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1) Member in good standing with Judo Alberta
- 2) Practices regularly at Judo Alberta Club (minimum 2 times a week)
- 3) Participates in two provincial camps or one provincial camp & one regional camp between September 01, 2025, and February 28, 2026
- 4) Participates at the <u>2026 Edmonton International</u> or <u>Veterans Championships</u> or any out of province veteran competition during the 2025-2026 season, and <u>2026</u> <u>Provincial Championships</u>
- 5) Participates in provincial camp or regional camp April/May 2026 Prior to the 2026 Open Nationals

## Selection procedure:

- A) Judo Alberta Coach Committee Reviews the athlete's minimum selection requirements. There can be a level of flexibility based on the athlete's activity level during the year. (Active is the key element for selection)
- B) Judo Alberta Executive Reviews the selection procedure
- C) Judo Alberta notifies Judo Club Coaches of athlete's final selection.
