Judo Alberta Ne-waza Selection Policy 2027 Open Nationals

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Member in good standing with Judo Alberta
2. Practices regularly at Judo Alberta Club (minimum 2 times a week)
3. Participates in one provincial training camp or two regional camps. (Sept-2025 – February 2026)
4. Participates in provincial camp or regional camp April/May 2026 Prior to the 2026 Open Nationals
5. **Participate in a Ne-waza competition during the 2026-2027 season. (September 2026 to April 2027)**

Selection procedure:

- A. Judo Alberta Coach Committee Reviews the athlete's minimum selection requirements.
- B. Judo Alberta notifies Judo Club Coaches of athlete's final selection.

Funding: Judo Alberta will not provide funding for ne-waza competitors.

Cost: The approx. cost for the 2027 Open Nationals will be \$200.00 - \$400.00

Judo Alberta Veterans Selection policy 2027 Open Nationals

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Member in good standing with Judo Alberta
2. Practices regularly at Judo Alberta Club (minimum 2 times a week)
3. **Participates in two provincial camps or one provincial camp & one regional camp between September 01, 2026, and February 28, 2027**
4. Participates at the 2027 Edmonton International or Veterans Championships or any out of province veteran competition during the 2025-2026 season, and 2027 Provincial Championships
5. Participates in provincial camp or regional camp April/May 2027 Prior to the 2027 Open Nationals

Selection procedure:

- A. Judo Alberta Coach Committee Reviews the athlete's minimum selection requirements. **There can be a level of flexibility based on the athlete's activity level during the year. (Active is the key element for selection)**
- B. Judo Alberta notifies Judo Club Coaches of athlete's final selection.

Funding: Judo Alberta will not provide funding for veteran competitors.

The programs of Judo Alberta are funded in part by the Government of Alberta.
